Did you know that Alaska is the least church-attending state in the US? It is far less churched than places like Haiti, Guatemala, Belize, and other central America/Caribbean countries. People think of Alaska as a tourist destination, but it is a serious mission field.

This trip will also allow people to get the feel of an international mission trip without all the worries that come with going international. Alaska will have several similarities to an international trip without the worries of passports, dangers, and threat of sickness.

Grace Works Alaska is a mission organization established in Anchorage, Alaska in 2007. They facilitate mission volunteers and church teams to work directly with non-churched children, youth, and adults in the local communities of the Anchorage area. Their heart is to see lives changed by the gospel of Jesus Christ.

We'll be feeding hungry, disadvantaged children a good lunch. In the afternoon, we will work in a local park teaching unchurched children and youth the Bible. We will support that work with games, crafts, music, and recreation. We will also host evangelistic community Park Parties in the evenings.

The estimated total cost is \$1,600 - \$1,750 and will include airfare, comfortable housing, all meals, transportation, most supplies, t-shirt, and a day of guided sightseeing.
